#### **SWIMMING SCHEME**

School Swimming Lessons will be held from Monday 19 November to Friday 30 November at Batemans Bay Pool. The bus will leave Mogo School at 12.15pm each day and return approx. 2pm.

Total cost of the 10 day program is:

### \$35 per student \$60 per family with two students **\$80 per family with three + students**

Students should bring a swimming costume, towel, sunscreen, t-shirt or rash shirt, hat and warm clothing on a cool day. Goggles and caps are optional and are the responsibility of your child.

Students will be assessed during the school swimming scheme for all water safety skills without wearing goggles.

The permission note was sent home and needs to be returned by Friday, 9 November.
