COVID

Things that haven't changed with COVID Guidelines

1. If a child or staff member has **tested positive**, they must isolate for 7 days and can leave isolation after 7 days **only if they are symptom-free**. They do not need to test before returning to school.
2. All positive COVID test results must continue to be reported to [Service NSW](#) and the school

Things that have changed with COVID Guidelines

Staff and students who are **close contacts** and **have no symptoms** are allowed to continue to attend school if they **follow guidelines agreed with NSW Health**.

1. **Students and staff must undertake daily RAT tests.**
2. **Students and Staff who are close contacts should wear masks at school where practical.**
